

Please review this Checklist – there are things for you to do!

- □ Complete your personalised **online student health questionnaire as soon as you can.** Please email us (<u>nurses@girton.cam.ac.uk</u>) if you do not receive this and it isn't in your junk folder! Before completing the form, *you will need to have the following information to hand*:
 - Dates of MMR and Men ACWY vaccines (if you have had these)
 - Names and dosage of any medication you are prescribed

PLEASE NOTE: The online form cannot be saved as you complete and will require completing in one go. Please make sure you allow enough time to do this.

□ If you have serious food or other allergies/medical conditions, please email the nurses asap! Our address is <u>nurses@girton.cam.ac.uk</u>. If you would like to speak with the nurses, get in touch using the same email address and we can arrange a call/zoom before you come to Girton. You can **book a 1:1** consultation, via the online booking system: <u>https://ob.rushcliff.com/holding-page/565304</u> (after term begins). These appointments run through Full Term only.

□ Useful items to bring

Some students have found it very useful to have the following with them:

- digital thermometer
- supply of face coverings
- hand sanitiser
- facial tissues
- over the counter medication such as paracetamol or cough/cold remedies, lozenges
- A hot water bottle and/or a re-useable heat/cold pack
- □ Vaccinations Ensure you have received the appropriate vaccinations before your arrival: <u>Vaccination Information August 2023.pdf</u>
- □ **Meningitis First year university students are part of an 'at risk' group for meningitis.** Check out the <u>signs and symptoms</u> or download the <u>Meningitis Now app</u> to ensure you have help and information at your fingertips.
- □ **Register with a GP Surgery on-line before arriving in Cambridge.** To register at Huntingdon Road Surgery (closest surgery to Girton), see New Patients > register online: <u>New Patients Huntingdon Road</u> <u>Surgery</u>
- Prescription medication ensure you bring sufficient supplies with you as Huntingdon Road Surgery is extremely busy at the start of term. If you are asthmatic, make sure you bring some spare inhalers. If you carry adrenaline auto-injectors, please ensure these are in date.
